1st year AP Art – 2D

1. Create a series of 10 drawings from observation. (drawings from looking at objects in real life). Create a variety of landscape, portrait, and still life drawing. Focus on line quality, proportion, composition, and value.
2. Take a series of 50 photographs to use as resource material for next year's artwork. You may use a cellphone camera for this. Photographs should include interesting textures, compositions, and value.
3. Research contemporary and artists through history that you like. Find two or three artists that inspire your own work.

2nd Year AP Art – Drawing

1. Using the back of your AP sketchbook from last year (or some other form of sketchbook), create a series of 10 drawings with a common theme. For example, plants, fruit/vegetables, portraits, buildings/houses.
2. Take a series of 50 photographs to use as resource material for next year's artwork. You may use a cellphone camera for this. Photographs should include interesting textures, compositions, and value.
3. Research contemporary and artists through history that you like. Find two or three artists that inspire your own work.
